WHICH OF MY PATIENTS WOULD BE SUITABLE?

Patients who fit any of the three cohorts listed below MAY be suitable:

Cohort One: Lower edentulous adult patients with unstable and/or unretentive lower complete dentures.
They may be dentate, partially dentate or edentulous in the upper arch.

Cohort Two: Upper edentulous adult patients with unstable and/or unretentive upper complete dentures.
They may be dentate, partially dentate or edentulous in the lower arch.

Cohort Three: Patients with missing lower incisor(s) or upper lateral incisor teeth.

HOW MUCH WILL MY PATIENTS SAVE?

We are offering discounted prices to all patients taking part in the study. As a guide, each mini-implant will cost £50 and for a full arch patients may need up to eight implants. A complete denture will cost £350 per arch making an approximate cost per arch of £750 - that's a huge saving of up to £6,000.
